“How can this man give us his flesh to eat?”

That is exactly the question the crowd asks Jesus in our Gospel today. For a good chunk of chapter 6, Jesus has been speaking of himself as a new manna. Both Jesus and the manna came down from heaven. Both Jesus and the manna were sent by the Father to strengthen Israel’s fledgling faith. Both Jesus and the manna of the Old Testament are miraculous. Seems like a good fit.

However, they begin to complain that Jesus is taking this metaphor too far. Is Jesus implying that they need to consume him? But Jesus doesn’t back down or explain his metaphor as he does in other instances of confusion (see Jn 3:3-5 or Mt 16:5-12). Rather he doubles down on exactly the thing that is troubling them:

Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. (John 6:53-54)

And it gets even more intense because he shifts from using the regular greek word for ‘to eat’ which is *esthio* (ἐσθίω) to the far more evocative word *trogo* (τρώγω) which describes the way animals eat. Think of chewing cud or a dog gnawing on a bone. Jesus seems to be speaking quite literally.

For some this is too much and they stop following Jesus. As Catholics we look at all of this, and the last supper accounts where Jesus gives his body and blood to his disciples and are convinced that the Eucharist really is the body and blood of Jesus and we are invited to receive it at every Mass.

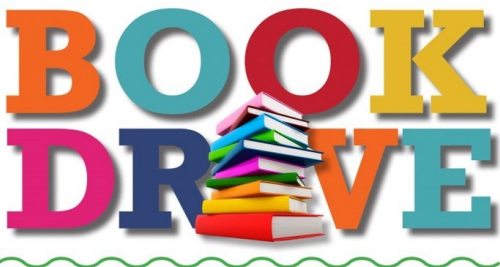
