Secrets, Secrets

In our Gospel today Jesus encourages his disciples to have no fear:

"Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known. (Mt 10:26)

But for most people that sounds horrible. *Everything* will be revealed? Everything I’ve done that I’m ashamed of or embarrassed of will one day come to light...and this is supposed to comfort me? However I think we need to keep two things in mind as we meditate on this passage.

First, being embarrassed or ashamed of our past is often a waste of time. God doesn’t ask us to wallow in shame for the rest of our days, he asks us to repent and move forward. For goodness sake Saint Paul was once a murderer of Christians! Our final ‘report card’ will not be weighing our merits and sins, but our merits and our unrepentant sins, because repentance is a profound process that changes us. We should be encouraged by the fact that one day every sin we’ve rejected and turned away from will come to light. Repentance is beautiful in God’s eyes.

Second, this passage ought to give us a little kick in the pants. If you’re like me and this passage is a bit anxiety inducing, stop for a moment and imagine living in such a way that you could read this passage and be excited. How freeing would that be? We ought to live and act in such a way that we are eager for the day when all things will be revealed. Let’s get to it.




