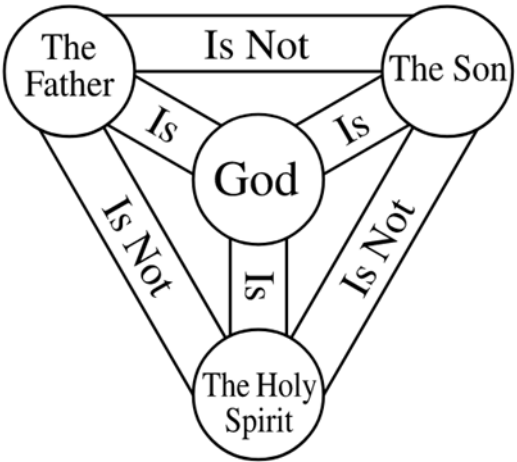

Explaining the Trinity

Trinity Sunday looms over many priests as they attempt to preach an entire homily without accidentally committing heresy. It turns out, it’s surprisingly difficult to explain...God. Just look at this classic diagram, yikes! So in a single bulletin article, here’s my best shot. (Please send all objections or claims of heresy to Rechelle’s office.)



In order to begin we need to understand two philosophic concepts: **nature** and **person**.

The word nature describes the kind of thing a given thing is. Sarah is a *human*. Spot is a *dog*. A hotdog is a *sandwich*. Just kidding, I know that’s a hotly contested debate, but it is a debate over a hotdog’s nature. In short, nature answers the question “**what is that?**”

When philosophers use the word person, they don’t necessarily mean a human, but a being with a nature that includes intellect and a free will. Persons have or will have the capacity to think and choose. Sarah is a person. So is Sarah’s baby brother *in utero*. So is St. Michael the Archangel. In short, person addresses the question, “**who is that?**”

Finally, let’s turn to the Trinity. Our belief as Christians is that God has revealed himself to be **one nature and three persons**. What is that? God. Who is that? The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

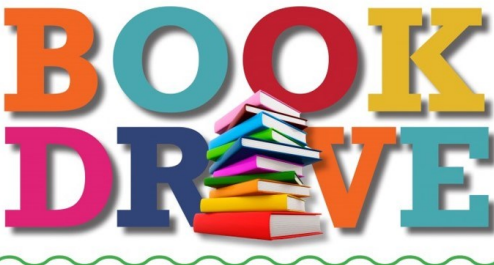
