From Fr Dan,

Hey... How's it going... that is... How is this Lent going for you? Is any Lenten practice/penance not working out? Tried to do too much, not enough, or just right?

We are celebrating the 5th Sunday of Lent today. So, how is this Lent going?

St. John tells us in this Sunday's Gospel, "Some Greeks who had come to worship at the Passover Feast came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee and asked him, 'Sir, we would like to see Jesus.'"

Now, this first part of today's Gospel might seem like something to just pass over, just go on by, but it is profound in that is what we all want— to see Jesus Christ, the Anointed One. (This is what the Christ means— the Anointed One.) It is a reason why God wants us to have the Lenten Season, not to just pass over it, just go on by. During the Lenten Season, we are to do the prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and penances to die to ourselves, to better order our passions and emotions to better fix our focus on the person Jesus the Christ. This is what we are told in the first sentence of John's Gospel today.

Now, the greatest way to see Jesus during our time here on earth is during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass since you actually see the Son of Man, the Son of God Himself. Not only do you see Him— His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity— the Most Holy Eucharist, but actually receive Him. You get to see Jesus the Christ, you get to worship Jesus the Christ, you get to receive Jesus the Christ.

Allow this remaining Lent to be that... this time to refocus, renew, reinvigorate your sight on Jesus and not pass Him on by.

Hang in there. May this be a most blessed Lent and may the Blessed Virgin Mary be ever present to you and your family on this day. Thanks. God bless.
