### St. George Mass Intention Policy

As Catholics, the practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for loved ones, living or deceased, is a long tradition. It is important that we not become superstitious or anxious about Mass intentions, however it is also true that the Mass is the most powerful prayer we as the Church have been given. If your family has never asked to have a Mass offered for your intentions I encourage you to. And yet, there are a limited number of Masses and to be fair, we have come up with a policy.

Therefore, the following guidelines will be followed at St. George for requesting Mass intentions effective immediately:

- 1. To ensure consistent and fair opportunity for all, only 10 Masses per year may be scheduled from each donor.
- 2. An exception would be if a person has already scheduled 10 Masses and a request for a recently deceased person would be requested.
- 3. Requests will be honored on a first come, first served basis.
- 4. Masses can be scheduled out one year from the calendar date.
- 5. A suggested stipend of \$10/per is to accompany each request.
- 6. You also have the choice of reaching out to other monasteries or religious orders throughout South Dakota or even the United States. The Adoration Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Joseph Cathedral take requests on their website.

Please remember that having a Mass intention simply means that the priest promises to offer the Mass for that intention, but every Catholic can offer their own prayers during Mass for particular intentions.


