Fraternal Correction

- In today’s Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples how to confront sin in our fellow Christians. We call this Fraternal Correction, that is calling our brother and sister Christians to repent and correct their behavior. This is a very neglected part of modern Christianity. We’re often too shy or adverse to confrontation to bring each other’s faults up, but this is something Jesus sees as integral to a community that follows him. Here are a couple of things to keep in mind if you feel called to fraternally correct someone:
- It’s for fellow Christians. There’s no use in saying “Don’t take the Lord’s name in vain” to someone who doesn’t believe Jesus is Lord. You’ll just be brushed off.
 - Go to the person. Gossip is not fraternal correction. We need to have the courage to speak directly to the person sinning against us.
 - Fraternal Correction should be selfless. I’m not correcting for my own benefit or comfort (this could be called nagging) but rather out of love for a brother who is putting his soul at risk.
 - To do this selflessly I may need some time to cool off and find that care for my brother in my heart.
 - Likewise I may need to pray or seek counsel before going to my brother to make sure that I’m in the right.
- If God is calling you, don’t be afraid to help a brother or sister to turn from sin and grow in holiness.
