Greetings in Christ! These past three months have been a whirlwind for us three priests going from St. Michael, to St. George, to celebrate mass at both prisons. It has been a blessing to experience the community of St. George and to meet and serve the men in our prisons. Yet, there is also a sense of distance from my St. Michael family, and with the rotating it seems harder to become immersed in the life of our extended pastorate family. So as of this moment I write to you knowing realistically that SET ABLAZE has its challenges for us priests and I'm sure also for you the Lay faithful.

This year is considered a transition year, that means we are in the planning phase. So at this moment we are where we should be, hopefully getting to know each other a little bit. You get to experience us priests and we get to experience you the people. This has been done through our weekend rotation. Hopefully, you have all had a chance to encounter each of us priests at mass.

The time has come to now move forward in developing a plan for our pastorate to be SET ABLAZE. The first phase is that we have compiled a 13 member team represented from both parishes that will develop a 6 to 10 year plan for our pastorate and submit some concrete steps we will take the first year to set our pastorate Ablaze to Bishop Degrood.

The pastoral plan focuses on 5 key areas for us as a pastorate: worship, evangelization, community, and service. This plan, though it is headed up by the pastoral planning team, cannot happen without your support. We desire to have your input as we move forward, especially through our town hall meetings and surveys, but don't be afraid to reach out with your own ideas via email or set up a time to discuss.

We will have two of them, one at St. George on Sept 21st (5:30pm mass, 6:00pm potluck, 6:30pm town hall) and St. Michaels on Sept 28th (5:30pm mass, 6:00pm potluck, 6:30pm town hall). All are welcome to either town hall, but please attend one.

The town halls this time will center on two key areas of the plan, worship and evangelization. Please be praying for these events and about these particular topics. Come prepared to share your ideas and your concerns. Again, what if your voice is the one meant to be heard but you failed to share. We want to hear from you. Hopefully working together as the Body of Christ and being docile to the Holy Spirit, St. Michael and St. George pastorate will be SET ABLAZE.


