

# BASICS

- **7 Sacraments (Initiation, Healing, Service) (gr 19-39, ch 8)**
  - Begins your life in the church, forgives all your past sins and makes you a child of God
  - Jesus extends His own ministry to Bishops, Priests and Deacons
  - Receive forgiveness of any mortal and venial sins we've committed after Baptism
  - Strengthens the grace of Baptism and is an outpouring of the Holy Spirit
  - Receive grace to help in the time of frailty, eminent death or serious sickness
  - One man and one woman give themselves to another in a union that is faithful and fruitful
  - Receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, under the appearance of bread and wine.

## FORTITUDE

Helps us to overcome difficulties with faith.



## PIETY

Moves us to treat God with the trust with which a child treats his Father.



## FEAR OF GOD

Compels us to flee from sin and always choose to please God.



## COUNSEL

Encourages us to follow the solution that most matches the glory of God and the good of others.



## UNDERSTANDING

Helps us understand the Word of God and the doctrines of faith.



## WISDOM

Makes us see all things in light of God and impels us to seek Him above all things.



## KNOWLEDGE

Helps us see the world from God's perspective.


