

Marriage Preparation Checklist

☐ Set your wedding date with a priest of a deacon at Holy Family Parish at least 10 months prior to your wedding date.
☐ Have a current Baptismal Certificate for the bride and groom each mailed to the priest or deacon.
☐ Reach out to Julia Schnellenberger at 317.626.3381 or schnellenberger@holyfamilystow.org to discuss who will provide music for your wedding.
☐ Read the HF Marriage Guidelines at holyfamilystow.org/matrimony.
$\ \square$ 10 months prior to your wedding date, schedule your first appointment with the priest or deacon who will prepare you.
\square Complete and return the Couples Ministry registration form the priest of deacon will give you at your first appointment.
\square Complete the online Prepare/Enrich inventory, the priest or deacon will initiate an email to you with instructions on taking the inventory online.
☐ Watch the 2 Natural Family Planning Introduction DVD's and go to holyfamilystow.org/matrimony for the before and after viewing couple discussion questions and other NFP resources for your education and information.
☐ Meet with the priest or deacon for a second appointment to begin reviewing the Prepare/Enrich inventory results, return your Couples Ministry registration form and the Natural Family Planning DVD's.
\square Begin to plan your wedding liturgy by completing the Wedding Mass/Service form the priest or deacon gives to you with the Wedding Planning Guide available at holyfamilystow.org/matrimony .
☐ Schedule your rehearsal day and time with the priest or deacon.
\square The Couples Minister assigned to you will contact you to schedule your first appointment with them. You will meet with them 4-5 times at days and times that work for you both.
$\hfill 2$ -3 months prior to your wedding, schedule an appointment with your wedding musicians to choose music for your wedding.
\square 1 month prior to your wedding, make contact or schedule an appointment with the priest or deacon to give them the complete Wedding Mass/Service Form.
☐ Obtain a civil marriage license from a County Probate Court in Ohio. It is good for 60 days. For Summit County, go to summitohioprobate.com/2014/12/03/im-getting-married-post/ .
\square At the rehearsal, give your civil marriage license and church donation to the priest or deacon.
