



Wedding Music List

The purpose of this list is to give you an idea of what music you will need for your wedding as well as what is appropriate for church. This will all be discussed and gone over in greater detail at the wedding music planning meeting 3-4 months prior to your wedding. Though the planning of your wedding music will not take place until 3-4 months before the wedding, we recommend that you reserve the musicians as soon as your wedding date is confirmed with the priest. You may also have a sung prelude, but all musical selections must be respectful and church appropriate. No secular songs may be used in the church.
