## Choosing a Saint's Name for Confirmation

### Why Choose a Confirmation Name?

A name identifies us in a unique way; not just our physical selves, but who we are as a person. One of the traditional practices in the Church at the time of Confirmation is choosing a name that will remind you of this Sacrament. Your prayerful reflection will help you to determine that name. You might want to recommit yourself to your Baptismal name since it expresses the relationship that exists between these two sacraments. You might want to choose the name of a saint who represents the type of Christian that you want to be. It is important to learn as much as you can about your patron saint. After all, you are asking this saint to be an advocate for you for the rest of your life. Whether you decide to stay with your Baptismal name or pick a new name, take the time to research and explore the meaning behind the name you choose, for as Scripture says, "Yahweh calls each of us by name."

Remember that the church's canonized saints are like members of the Catholic "Hall of Fame." They were not canonized as saints because they are "perfect people" or have "ideals we can never live up to." They are canonized because of their willingness to love and serve the Lord. Their stories and lives have inspired believers throughout history.

## The Role of a Confirmation Sponsor

"Candidates for Confirmation, as for Baptism, fittingly seek the spiritual help of a sponsor. To emphasize the unity of the two sacraments, it is appropriate that this be one of the baptismal godparents." (#1311 Catechism of the Catholic Church)

In the Diocese of San Bernardino, there is to be only <u>one</u> sponsor for each candidate for Confirmation who is to be at least 18 years of age and is a fully initiated Roman Catholic; a person who has received Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. If married, must be married in the Catholic Church. The Sponsor <u>cannot</u> be a parent, nor can they act as proxies.

The most important role of Confirmation sponsors is to journey with the candidates and guide them as they prepare to receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit in this Sacrament of Initiation, and to continue to help them live out their mission as fully initiated Catholics especially after the celebration. They are to listen attentively to candidates and affirm their strengths. They are to share in the catechetical sessions, rites, retreats and service projects whenever possible. Sponsors act in the name of the Church; they have the responsibility to witness to the faith through their actions.

As a Sacramental Sponsor, I will become responsible to be a model and example to the Candidate as a committed and active Catholic; to be a support to his/her life in the practice of our Catholic Faith. Therefore, I will affirm to commit to my Catholic Faith; that I am Baptized and Confirmed in it and able to receive the Holy Eucharist.

"The sponsor brings the candidate to receive the sacrament, presents him to the minister for anointing, will later help him fulfill his baptismal promises faithfully under the influence of the Holy Spirit." Rite of Confirmation

Every effort is to be made to insure that the sponsor for Confirmation will be present and accompany the candidate at the liturgical celebration of the Rite of Confirmation. The sponsor serves as a mentor/guide in the faith and should have regular contact with the candidate. Living at a remote distance from the Confirmation candidate is not an excuse for the sponsor's absence during the celebration of the rite itself.

Having explained that, there may emergency situations where the sponsor may not be able to be physically present for the celebration of the rite. Such reasons may include illness, inclement weather, and national emergencies. In this extreme emergency absence of the sponsor, a witness is required who can attest to the administering of the sacrament. The only requirements for the witness are that he or she be practicing Catholic and at least 18 years of age. This may include the person who prepared the candidate for the sacrament.

### **Confirmation Sponsor Guidelines**

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The sponsor for a candidate of the sacrament of Confirmation has a unique role as teacher, spiritual guide and companion on this journey through the process of confirmation to full initiation within the Church. When choosing a sponsor, the candidate should look for someone that the candidate desires to share in that same faith life.

A sponsor must be able to fulfill the conditions mentioned in Cannon 874

### Cannon Law 874

To be permitted to take on the function of sponsor a person must:

- 1. Be designated by the one to be Baptized/Confirmed.
- 2. Be of age Set by Bishop (18 years of age in The Diocese of San Bernardino)
- 3. Be a fully initiated Catholic
- 4. Practicing Catholic (not bound by canonical penalty)
- 5. Not be the father or mother of the one to be Baptized/Confirmed.

The candidate should be allowed to choose his or her own sponsor. It is the task of the parent to assist your son or daughter to reflect on an adult member of the faith community who has influenced their faith development or who has been an example to them of a person living a faithful life. The candidate should not rush into asking just anyone, but should spend time in prayer and reflection about this invitation, but should be chosen in the first year.

The following are a few items to consider when thinking about different people in your life:

- 1. Do you feel comfortable talking and sharing with this person?
- 2. Are you willing to spend time outside of church with this person?
- 3. Do you look up to and respect this person?
- 4. Do you feel this person will listen and respect your views and questions?
- 5. Do you feel that this person will guide and teach you through this process of confirmation?
- 6. Do you see this person at church and participating within the community?

### The following are things to think about:

- Your sponsor may be your Baptismal sponsor.
- 2. Your sponsor may be either male or female.
- 3. Your sponsor must accept the invitation to help you prepare by being a friend, witness and guide.
- 4. Your sponsor must agree to participate in special meetings, workshops and liturgies, retreats during the process.
- 5. Your sponsor must be willing to continue to be a friend, witness and guide after your confirmation.
- 6. If married, your sponsor must be married in the Catholic church.
