

From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

As I am writing this, the thermometer is reading 97 degrees. Jesus said in today's Gospel passage that He has come to set the world on fire...well, part of me wants to shout out, "Cool it, Jesus! The world is hot enough!"



Cool it, Jesus.

All references to climate change and summer heat put aside, we do sometimes want to tell Jesus to cool it, don't we? I mean, we like the nice gentle, moderate Jesus, right? The one who offers nice platitudes and beatitudes and fortitudes...No?! We recall the images of the good shepherd leading his flock to springs of lifegiving water, the Jesus whose yoke is easy and burden light, the Isaiahan servant who won't quench the smoldering wick or snap off the bruised reed. We like Jesus who is the way, the truth and the life; Jesus the babe born at Bethlehem, the Jesus who tells funny parables about weeds and wheat, fig trees and mustard seeds, good Samaritans and prodigal sons. We love the Jesus who walks on water and occasionally turns the ubiquitous stuff into wine! Now that's the Jesus I want to get to know better! Mellow Jesus. Kind Jesus. Loving Jesus. Chill Jesus.

Go to the Gospels yourselves and you will find all of the above. It's all true, all real, all accurate. Jesus was all of this and more.

But in that "more," you will also find a fiery, passionate, hot-tempered, zealous, practically fanatical Jesus who absolutely obsessed with proclaiming a Kingdom that was already coming, already here...where sin and evil would have no place, where nothing and no one could get in the way of God's purifying will. This Incendiary Jesus had no problem causing division in the name of the truth. He did not shy away from insulting the Pharisees and Sadducees, the Scribes and the Temple leadership. He had no use for Pilates and Herods, kings and procurators. He had no issue with dividing even the most tight-knit of families in their choice to follow Him or not. "Let the dead bury their dead, but you! Come follow me!" Now! Right now! He overturned money-changers' tables, scattered oxen, made a whip of cords and drove the merchants from the Temple. There was an immediacy to His message and an uncompromising urgency that absolutely nothing get in the way of genuine discipleship. Tabasco Jesus! Habanero Jesus! Fire-in-thebelly Jesus! Laser-focused Jesus! Hutzpah Jesus!

Jesus was such a firebrand that even His disciples would try to tell Him to lighten-up from time to time..., only to earn a sharp rebuke or reproach. "Get behind me, Satan!" He once growled at Peter when he tried to dissuade Him from talking about His impending suffering and death. No doubt that even Judas was embracing a less-caustic version of who the Lord truly was.

And so lies the danger for all of us today. Do we want a watered-down version of Jesus Christ in our lives, or do we want the whole Lord—fire and ice—gentle shepherd and

emblazoned leader-ardent evangelist and loving saviorall at once? Because, here's the thing: there was only one Jesus, one Lord, one Savior. Jesus was all of the above in all of its seeming incongruity. Yet the Lord was not schizophrenic or cursed with a Dr. Jekel and Mr. Hyde personality complex. He was simply truly God and truly human. He was genuine and complex in every way that we are, embodying the sublime presence of a transcendent God.

To truly know Him and become an authentic disciple, we must welcome all of these varied "moments" of Christ into our lives. Our God-made-flesh must be 3-dimensional and real, lifelike and life-giving. And for that to happen, we cannot settle with seeing only one part of our Redeemer and shunning the other, disturbing, challenging and unsettling aspects. Jesus came not to bring peace in any way that the world measures it, but rather to set things ablaze that hearts may be rendered and sins forgiven. All is at stake in this struggle to know Him.

Let us not settle for a bland, milquetoast savior, but instead open ourselves to the life-altering task of reconciling within our hearts the many seemingly paradoxical faces of Christ in our response to His searing love. So..., Kaleidoscope Jesus, Polychromatic Jesus, Prismatic Jesus, Multiverse Jesus, Full-Spectrum Jesus, Symphonic Jesus...

Back in 2009 when a number of IC parishioners formed a nonprofit charitable organization to help the people of Haiti, they called the organization IC Haiti. The "IC" both identified our parish and stood for the words "I see." Other parishioners were quickly and kindly invited to see the impoverished Haitian people as well. And so, IC Haiti, through the generosity of IC parishioners and other kind supporters, has generously served the community of Puit Chacha for the past thirteen years, providing funding for an elementary school, a well for drinking water, a hot lunch program for the school children, tuition for those pursuing a secondary level education, a dental program, hurricane and earthquake relief, and anti-virus healthcare resources through St. Boniface Hospital. IC Haiti will continue to "see" the needs of our brothers and sisters in Haiti for we also see that our sustained support continues to offer them hope.

In the Parable of the Last Judgement in the 25th chapter of St. Matthew's Gospel, Our Lord says to those who have been welcomed into the kingdom of heaven "Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me."

The First Parish Newbury Food Pantry is the largest all-volunteer food pantry in the greater Newburyport area serving the communities of Newbury, Newburyport, Byfield, West Newbury, Salisbury, Amesbury, Rowley, Ipswich, and Georgetown. They fulfill orders for over 400 people each Friday.

Lawn tickets (bring your own blanket or chair) are \$30. Children under 12 are free. 


