

First Parish Newbury Food Pantry Benefit Concert

The Essex Ensemble, directed by local resident and food pantry volunteer Andrew Price and featuring top-tier musicians from several of Boston's most highly regarded orchestras, will perform on August 27 from 6–8 p.m. at Maudslay Arts Center (Maudslay State Park, 95 Curzon Mill Rd, Newburyport) to benefit the First Parish Newbury Food Pantry's mission to end food insecurity in the region.

The First Parish Newbury Food Pantry is the largest all-volunteer food pantry in the greater Newburyport area serving the communities of Newbury, Newburyport, Byfield, West Newbury, Salisbury, Amesbury, Rowley, Ipswich, and Georgetown. They fulfill orders for over 400 people each Friday.

Patrons are encouraged to bring a picnic to the concert. There will be non-alcoholic beverages and desserts available. Reserved table seats are \$50 per person in tables of 3 or 4. Lawn tickets (bring your own blanket or chair) are \$30. Children under 12 are free. Whether you choose to sit at a patio table or on a blanket under the stars, every seat offers excellent acoustics.

Doors open at 5:30 p.m. Parking at Maudslay Arts Center is limited to vehicles with handicapped stickers. Regular parking is at the main Maudslay State Park lot which has free parking after 5:30 p.m. Ushers will be on hand to direct you.

Over the years we have continued to hold regular collections for ongoing church maintenance. This has been to cover all kinds of various repairs and upkeep that our older buildings are in constant need of. In the coming weeks, we will be engaging contractors to work on repairing, painting, and sealing the upper trim and brick facades of the church in addition to adding snow screens to help prevent falling ice and snow from injuring people as it melts and comes off the roof. Additionally, we be installing supplemental heat pump units to augment the HVAC systems in the foyer and sacristy of the church. We have also decided not to place trash barrels throughout the cemetery with the hope that this will encourage people to take any trash or discarded items with them. It is also our hope that this will discourage people from littering and piling trash in the barrels because they are under the impression that there is regular trash removal. The cost of regular trash removal would be prohibitive.






