



HRIC Jubilee Pilgrimage

St. Joseph the Worker Shrine, Lowell, MA Monday, September 29, 2025 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

This Jubilee year 2025 recommends a pilgrimage by the faithful to designated holy sites throughout the world. St. Joseph the Worker Shrine in Lowell is one of the designated sites for the Archdiocese of Boston.

The shrine was established by Father André Garin who left Canada as a seminarian for a mission to minister to the French speaking workers in the various mills. He returned following his ordination and succeeded in eliminating barriers to worship by celebrating Mass in French familiar to those who had immigrated from Canada. The downtown church was established in 1956 and dedicated to St. Joseph the Worker in honor of those early parishioners.

A Collaborative pilgrimage is planned to the shrine on Monday, September 29, leaving at 8:30 a.m. from the Immaculate Conception parking lot. We will carpool to the shrine and be greeted by Brother Richard Cote of the Missionary Oblates of Mary who are the stewards of the shrine.

Following a tour of the shrine and museum by Brother Richard, OMI, we will have an opportunity for confession, a trip to the gift shop and Mass at noon, con-celebrated by Fr. Harrison.




