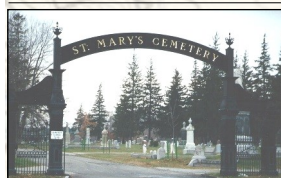

We ask that **sandwiches** be cut and individually wrapped, then placed in the bread wrapper. Please label the bread wrapper with the variety of sandwich inside. Cold cuts with cheese and peanut butter & jelly are favorites. *Please do not use condiments.*

Also welcome are party-sized **powdered drink mixes** such as iced tea, lemonade, and Kool-Aid, along with fresh **fruits** and goodies. If you have an abundant harvest from your **garden**, consider bringing a few extra vegetables along with your sandwiches, soups, or casseroles. They will be greatly appreciated!

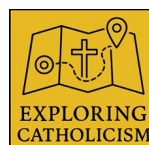

The Sacrament of the Sick

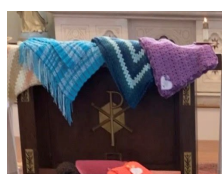

Ordinary Time Retreat

Walking Humbly with God

Exploring the virtue of humility, that softens the heart hardened by pride to acknowledge our woundedness and need for help.

Ordinary Time is a season of spiritual growth and maturation as we listen to and reflect on Jesus' teachings and actions. Both reveal the key role of humility in accepting Jesus' invitation to follow him and lose our life to save it. Humility allows us to live a right relationship with God, acknowledging and accepting our dependence on him. Humility frees us from the prison of pride and the illusion of self as center to live in truth and freedom.

God is constantly working for our becoming whole in Him. With love he prunes us, reveals our weakness, our sinfulness, our shadow side, our fears. He humbles us so we can learn the truth, acknowledge our human limitations, and weaknesses and turn to God for healing and help.

Our retreat will explore the role of humility in spiritual maturation through reflection on scripture and Jesus of Nazareth's human experience of learning obedience from what he suffered.

I will provide material for reading and reflection from scripture and a variety of spiritual teachers that reflect the retreat's theme and your unique desires. We will meet in person or by Zoom for spiritual direction sessions you schedule throughout retreat. Between our times of spiritual direction you may pause, ponder, pray, and open yourself to grace.

As we open ourselves to the Holy Spirit's wisdom, I will listen deeply as you share and together, we allow the Holy Spirit to move us and bless and guide our sharing. This offering is designed to provide an affordable, convenient retreat that creates an intimate space for you to share yourself deeply with the Holy Spirit's guidance.

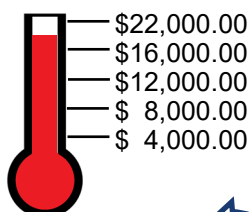

You also know how hard and how cheerfully their family and friends worked together after the Masses to make sure this fundraiser would be a success.

This year's bake sale raised \$6,060, and that total was matched by a generous donor bringing the total to \$12,120.

Below are the fundraising totals from 2015 to 2025 for the IC Haiti Bake Sale (formerly called "Cookies for Haiti").

- Funds raised directly from the bake sales = \$44,596
- Funds raised from matching gifts+ = \$45,067
- Total funds raised between 2015 and 2025 = \$89,663

(The IC Haiti Bake Sale fundraiser was not held during the 2021 pandemic year. This year's fundraiser marks the 10th time it's been held.)

Also, any help with clean up after the fair is always appreciated.



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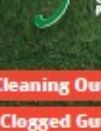
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
