IC Haiti and Hurricane Melissa

On November 4 the IC Haiti Board of Directors received the update below from the Chief Program Director of Health Equity International (HEI) following late October's Hurricane Melissa:

The Chacha school remained in session for the first two days of last week (October 27–31) with a full day on Monday and a half day on Tuesday. However, due to heavy rainfall, classes were suspended for the remainder of the week. On Thursday and Friday, the government declared a state of emergency.

Dr. Miliane attempted to visit the school last Thursday, but poor road conditions made the trip impossible. I am pleased to report that the school remains standing, and classes have resumed this week.

We continue to monitor the situation closely to better understand the ongoing impacts on the community.

As IC Haiti continues to receive updates, we will keep you, the parishioners of Holy Redeemer and Immaculate Conception, informed. Thanks to all who contributed to Catholic Relief Services to help with hurricane relief efforts in the Caribbean.






