

Chacha, Haiti. For the past fifteen years we have provided for their educational, nutritional, safety, and health needs despite all the violent political disruptions and natural disasters in Haiti.

Let us not give up on our brothers and sisters in Haiti. Just as the Good Samaritan didn't give up on the beaten



man he found on the road to Jericho. Just as the Prodigal Son's father did not give up on him. Just as Our Crucified Lord did not give up on the thief who was dying at his side. Just as Our Lord has not given up on us.

In this regard, please take some time to reflect upon the inspiring words of Pope Leo at the end of his recent letter "Dilexi Te" to Christians throughout the world.

Our love and our deepest convictions need to be continually cultivated, and we do so through our concrete actions. Remaining in the realm of ideas and theories, while failing to give them expression through frequent and practical acts of charity, will eventually cause even our most cherished hopes and aspirations to weaken and fade away. For this very reason, we Christians must not abandon almsgiving. It can be done in different ways, and surely more effectively, but it must continue to be done. It is always better at least to do something rather than nothing. Whatever form it may take, almsgiving will touch and soften our hardened hearts. It will not solve the problem of world poverty, yet it must still be carried out, with intelligence, diligence, and social responsibility. For our part, we need to give alms as a way of reaching out and touching the suffering flesh of the poor. (119)

Christian love breaks down every barrier, brings close those who were distant, unites strangers, and reconciles enemies. It spans chasms that are humanly impossible to bridge, and it penetrates to the most hidden crevices of society. By its very nature, Christian love is prophetic: it works miracles and knows no limits. It makes what was apparently impossible happen. Love is above all a way of looking at life and a way of living it. A Church that sets no limits to love, that knows no enemies to fight but only men and women to love, is the Church that the world needs today. (120)

St. Ann's First Mass

Christmas Day 1879



Around 1877, Sunday Mass was being held at the West Newbury Town Hall. Fr. Edward McClure, the priest at that time, saw the Catholic congregation growing in W. Newbury and realized there was an urgent need for an actual church building. In 1878, funds were raised for the new church and property located on the corner of Main and

Church streets was purchased. Ground was broken and construction commenced by Thomas Whelan of Haverhill. The church was completed in 1879 with the first Mass being said on **Christmas Day** of that same year. The following year, on May 2, 1880, the new church was officially dedicated to St. Ann.
