



Jubilee 2025—Introducing a Holy Year of Hope



A jubilee year is a time for forgiveness and renewal in our relationship with God. Jubilee years were initially marked in Scripture by the remittance of debt and property, and the healing of relationships. The Holy Father desires that this jubilee year will be a "moment of genuine, personal encounter with the Lord Jesus, the 'door' (cf. Jn

10:7-9)" (Spes NonConfundit, 1).

The 2025 Jubilee officially opened on December 24, 2024, with the rite of Opening of the Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of St. Peter by the Holy Father, who then presided over the celebration of the Night Mass of the Lord's Birth inside the Basilica. The year will end in Rome on January 6, 2026. (from the Archdiocese of Boston website)

Archbishop Richard Henning officially opened the Jubilee Year in Boston on December 29, 2024 at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross. The year in Boston will end on December 28, 2025.

A variety of events are planned in our Collaborative to celebrate this Year of Hope beginning with prayer and song on the weekend of March 1 and 2. Keep an eye on the bulletin, website, and social media for more information.

Due to varied schedules and availability, it may not always be possible for a priest to come on short notice to offer the Sacrament, therefore it is strongly recommended that you request the Anointing of the Sick before going in for a hospital stay, upon entering a nursing home, or at the beginning of hospice care. 

Directed Lenten Retreat

Lent: A Time of Choice, Challenge and Change, Exploring the cost of becoming Jesus' disciple by carrying your cross each day.

If anyone wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wishes to finds his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. (Lk. 9:23–24)

Ash Wednesday begins the Lenten season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that leads to Easter with a call to turn away from sin, repent, and return to the gospel and ashes that mark us as followers of Christ. Lenten ashes symbolize humility and the need to develop a spirit of sacrifice for others and surrender of self to God. They remind us that humans are mortal and will return to dust and now is time to say "Yes" to Jesus' invitation. As you are marked with ashes you say "Yes" to Jesus' call to change and follow him. Ashes are a public proclamation of your desire and intention to die to self and live in Jesus the Christ.

This retreat will focus on the inner work of Lent signified by the outward sign of ashes. It will provide a time and space to engage in interior work to support and explore your public proclamation and respond to Jesus' call. Lent is a time of choice, challenge, and change. In Luke we hear Jesus invite us to follow him *if* we are willing to pay the cost of discipleship and be changed. What concretely, does Jesus mean by this?

Richard Rohr's response to this question with insights gathered from James Martin's book, *Jesus: A Pilgrimage*, namely taking up your cross daily and giving up your life in order to find a deeper life in Christ means six interpenetrating things that we will explore along with other questions. Why is suffering necessary and salvific? What supports you to change? How do you pray? What is hard to surrender? Where do you resist change? Do you believe in Jesus' promise? The season of Lent calls us to reflect on and explore such questions with faith.

I will provide material for reading and reflection from scripture and a variety of spiritual teachers that reflect your unique relationship with God as we explore these and other questions you may have. We will meet for four in-person or Zoom spiritual direction sessions you schedule throughout the retreat. As we open ourselves to the Holy Spirit's wisdom, I will listen deeply as you share, and together, we allow the Holy Spirit to move us and bless and guide our sharing. This offering is designed to provide an affordable, convenient retreat that creates an intimate space for you to share yourself deeply with the Holy Spirit's guidance.

If your child is entering **8th grade** in the fall, but has not received Faith Formation in recent years, enrolling them in the Summer Faith Formation Week is a great way to catch them up and get in a prerequisite year before they receive the Sacrament of Confirmation (8th graders can begin preparation for Confirmation only if they have attended recent Faith Formation with us).


