



Marc Piché Elementary School recently informed us that despite the many social, economic, and political troubles the Haitian people have suffered through in recent years, the school continues to operate. Puit Chacha, where our school is, and Fond des Blancs, where both the secondary schools and St. Boniface Hospital are located, are somewhat distant from areas where gang violence is concentrated. The school administrator assured us that both the elementary and secondary schools continue to provide the school children education, a hot meal, and a safe learning environment daily.

Thank you, fellow parishioners, for helping to keep hope alive for the school community of Puit Chacha. Your quarterly contributions are keeping the school open. This is one way for us to fulfill the challenge Pope Francis offered us at the beginning of this Jubilee Year: be Pilgrims of Hope, especially to those most in need.

For Father Timothy "Tim" Harrison Priest, Pastor, Pilgrim, Our Friend

I was young, a fledgling flyer, Selling bulletins, full of fire. Dreaming big with ink and thread, Chasing churches, forging ahead.

In Gloucester, where the salt winds blow, And fishermen in prayer would go, There stood a pastor, firm and kind— But not yet sold on what I'd find.

Father Tim, with flock and flame,
Held the biggest parish name.
I knocked and knocked but heard no call,
The doors were busy, after all.
The tides would turn, the parishes merged,
The past and future sweetly surged.
My smaller gains had slipped away,
But God was painting - in His way!

Then one day, fate realigned,
And where do you think he was assigned?
Newburyport, IC my home, my shore—
And there he stood behind the door.

I made a pilgrimage that day, To shake his hand, to smile and say: "I'm your man, for bulletins and more— Let's walk together through this door."

And walk we did, with years unrolled, With sermons deep and stories told. No longer just a vendor's game, But friendship lit with holy flame.

From pew to pulpit, Rome to Lourdes,
Our journeys stretched in leaps and bounds.
To the Holy Land, where Lord Jesus trod,
We've been where saints had stood with God

We followed Saint Paul through Grecian skies— Philippi, Athens, Corinth's cries. Thessalonica's ancient roads, Still echoed with the truths he sowed.



Through Ephesus, Patmos, where the visions stirred, And Istanbul, where East conferred. To Fatima, where Saint Mary weeps, Lanciano, Loreto, where mystery sleeps.

We climbed to Saint Peter's sacred dome, In Rome, that feels like a second home. We breathed in the peace at Assisi's gate, In Siena's grace, and Amalfi's place.

In Sicily's sun, in Milan's square, By Lake Como's quiet prayer— Each step, each Mass, each sacred meal, Made heaven's nearness feel more real.

He made us laugh, he made us think, He poured out joy like sacred ink. A preacher, pastor, guide, and friend— The kind on whom your soul depends.

For many years, we've made our climb, Through sacred ground and holy times. With footprints left in every land, We journey still, by God's command.

Then last September, my breath grew thin— A cardiac storm roared deep within. Clinically gone, they said I lay, In the twilight stretched between night and day.

But grace had hands, and robes, and oil— And prayers that softened mortal toil. For there he came—my brother, priest— To bless the broken, anoint the least.

He stood with courage, stood with care, Anointed me with healing prayer. And should that journey have reached its close, He would have surely sent me where Love grows.

No words can hold what he has given— A path back home, a glimpse of heaven. Not just a guide through the churches of Rome But one who'd walk me fully home.

For a score and seven years, He's calmed our doubts and dried our tears. A shepherd strong in storm and sun, And still, his work is just begun.

So here's to Father Tim—beloved, kind, wise,
With mercy shining in his eyes.
The road ahead still sings and bends—
With more saints, more sermons, more pilgrim friends.






