

The school administrator assured us that both the elementary and secondary schools continue to provide the school children education, a hot meal, and a safe learning environment daily.

Thank you, fellow parishioners, for helping to keep hope alive for the school community of Puit Chacha. Your quarterly contributions are keeping the school open. This is one way for us to fulfill the challenge Pope Francis offered us at the beginning of this Jubilee Year: be Pilgrims of Hope, especially to those most in need.






