

Our Polish Saints

The First Polish Pope - Saint John Paul II **Totus Tuus**

Saint John Paul II broke many traditions throughout his life and in his 26 years of papal ministry.

The first non- Italian Pope since Adrian VI was installed in 16th century, he was an actor, an avid skier, and a linguist. In his early days as Archbishop of Krakow he worked diligently to end Communist rule in Poland and Eastern Europe.



Born Karol Wojtyła in Poland in 1920, he moved to Krakow after the death of his mother and entered the University in 1938. His studies were interrupted by World War II, and he worked in a quarry from 1940 until 1942 when he entered a clandestine seminary. He resumed his studies at University in 1945 and was ordained a priest in 1946.

Pope Pius XII appointed Father Woityła auxiliary bishop of Krakow in July of 1948, and he was ordained in Wawel Cathedral in September 1958. In 1964, Pope Paul VI appointed Bishop Wojtyła as Archbishop of Krakow and in June 1967, appointed him a Cardinal.

As Bishop, he took part in the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965) and made a significant contribution to the drafting of the first Constitution Gaudium et Spes. He also attended the five assemblies of the Synod of Bishops prior to the start of his Pontificate. He was instrumental in the creation of the universal Catechism of the Catholic Church and the Code of Canon Law.

On October 16, 1978, Cardinal Wojtyła was elected Pope, and he chose the name of John Paul II. On October 22, he began his lengthy ministry on the chair of St. Peter.

An attempt was made on Pope John Paul II's life in Saint Peter's Square on May 3, 1981. Following a prolonged stay in the hospital, he forgave the attempted assassin and visited him in prison. In thanksgiving, he commissioned a painting of the Holy Mother which was placed on the wall of the Vatican overlooking the site of the attempted assassination.

Pope John Paul II died on the April 2 2005, the vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday, which he had instituted. He was buried in the crypt of Saint Peter's Basilica below the high altar.

John Paul II was beatified in Saint Peter's Square on May 1, 2011 by Pope Benedict XVI, and his coffin was transferred to the left of the Altar of St. Sebastian in the Basilica. He was canonized on April 27, 2014, together with Pope John XXIII, by Pope Francis.






