Due to varied schedules and availability, it may not always be possible for a priest to come on short notice to offer the Sacrament, therefore it is strongly recommended that you request the Anointing of the Sick **before going in for a hospital stay, upon entering a nursing home, or at the beginning of hospice care**. Guidelines for Lent

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent.

Fasting during Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. Catholics age 18–59 are bound to the obligation of fasting. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including water, milk, and fruit juices are allowed.

Abstinence during Lent

Abstinence is observed on *all* Fridays of Lent. Abstinence is the absence of meat all day. Fish is allowed during Lent, though. All Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligation of abstinence.

Cross Catholic Outreach at IC



Please welcome Fr. Phong Pham, who will be visiting IC next weekend.

He comes to us from Cross Catholic Outreach and will share some touching stories about the amazing work Catholic missions are accomplishing worldwide.

Fr. Pham was born in Da Nang, Vietnam, one of 10 siblings. In 1975, he was separated from his family

during the fall of South Vietnam, reuniting with them three years later in Hong Kong. They eventually settled in the U.S., and at 16, he entered St. Joseph High School Seminary in the Diocese of Grand Rapids, Michigan. He was ordained in June 1991. In 2008, moved by a desire to serve the poor in his homeland, he was incardinated into the Diocese of Thanh Hóa, Vietnam, serving as Episcopal Vicar and General Coordinator for Vietnamese Catholics in North America.

In 2016, Pope Francis named him a Papal Missionary of Mercy. At the bishop's request, he relocated to Boston in 2018, where Cardinal Seán O'Malley entrusted him with establishing Blessed Andrew Phu Yen Parish. In 2022, he returned to Michigan as pastor of Holy Redeemer Parish. As an Outreach Priest with Cross Catholic Outreach, he now travels the U.S., inspiring others to bring hope to families in need.

Immaculate Conception School

Professional Women's Hockey Player Inspires Immaculate Conception School Students

Boxford native Anna Bargman visited Immaculate Conception School last Monday. Anna is a rookie for the New York Sirens, the professional women's hockey team, but also the niece of the IC's middle school math teacher, Mrs. Jen Godfrey. On break from the season's hockey schedule due to the Olympics, Anna dedicated the day to our school students, sharing her journey and insights with students in grades 1–8. Her visit provided some sound advice as



she encouraged students to balance school, sports, and personal well-being.

During her talk, Anna emphasized the importance of staying positive and working hard, even when setbacks arise. She discussed how she managed academics alongside a demanding athletic schedule, highlighting that time management, problem solving and seeking academic support, especially as a college student at Yale University, were key to her success. She encouraged students to maintain a healthy, active lifestyle—not just for athletic performance, but for overall well-being.



With the middle school students, Anna addressed questions they had submitted in advance. She advised students to play a variety of sports, explaining that this helped her avoid burnout and deepened her love for hockey. Anna stressed that learning to "read the game"—understanding what's happening on the ice or field—builds skills that go beyond sports, such as teamwork, critical thinking, and adaptability.

For the 8th graders preparing for high school, Anna shared a crucial piece of advice: choose a high school you'll love, especially if you can't play your favorite sport. She reminded them that personal happiness and a supportive environment are just as important as athletic opportunities. Anna stays balanced by embracing each moment, and appreciates where she is at this point in time, knowing that playing hockey professionally will not be forever. As a nod to her aunt, Anna's answer to the question, "How does math play into your career?" got a lot of laughs when Anna's response was, "Well, you have to be able to count to 5! It's harder than you think. The coaches are always yelling, 'There are 6 men on the ice!!'"

Anna's visit left a lasting impression on the Immaculate Conception School community, inspiring students to pursue their passions, stay active, and remember that the lessons learned in sports apply to all areas of life.






