2. **What has been since last time:** Deacon Steve and Tad Dinkins
 - a. Have received PPC loans

- i. Money is in our accounts
 - 1. Primary purpose of money for payroll, health insurance, and retirement plan
 - ii. Loan forgiveness
 - 1. Calculation will be done by the end of June (probably 75-80%)
- b. State of the Parish letter
 - i. Since Tuesday 4/28, we have received \$147,000
- c. Deficit has increased
 - i. Due to lack of public liturgies
 - ii. Tuition payments are mostly done in the Fall

3. Public Masses

- a. Challenges
 - i. Daily noon Mass will be public
 - ii. Saturday evening will be public
 - iii. Sunday 10am will be public
 - iv. Spanish 12pm will still be only livestream
 - 1. Possible COVID-19 contamination
 - v. St. Rose and St. Lawrence
- b. Only chapel side entrance only
 - i. 3-week job in the narthex
 - ii. Greeters have masks, gloves
- c. Block off Church to where people will sit
 - i. Assign places to sit
 - ii. For cleaning purposes
- d. Minimal number of Masses
 - i. Slowly reintroduce the Masses
- e. Distributing will be done through by the priests and deacons
 - i. Single line with six feet spacing
- f. Encouraging the elderly to continue to watch livestream
- g. Separating Church into different section
 - i. Ushers will be assigned seating
- h. Encouraging people to bring their own masks and hand sanitizers
- i. Purchase baskets with handles for collection
- j. Archbishop left it up to pastors to decide about when and how to open parishes
- k. Hopefully having First Communion and Confirmation on May 31st at Pentecost
 - i. Only person receiving sacrament and their family

 - i. Working on good contacts
- b. Also working on "our story" of St. Patrick and Bergan
 - i. Share online etc.
- c. Offertory committee
 - i. Communication sent out multiple times per week
 - ii. Teaching people what is tithing and how-to sacrificial give to the parish
