Baptism of Infants and Young Children

To prepare for your child's baptism (ages 6 and under), registered members of the parish (if you are not yet registered, you may do so at the same time that you register for Baptism) must stop in at the parish office to get a baptism packet. Forms for each child being baptized need to be completed and returned to the office, and the baptism preparation class taken (if applicable), prior to baptism day.

We welcome the newly baptized and pray for the parents who are the first teachers of their children in the ways of faith.
