Their mission is: “To make euthanasia, infanticide, abortion and destruction of human embryos socially, ethically and legally unacceptable solutions to human problems and to promote positive alternatives to each of these acts.”

WRL accomplishes this through:

- Education and advertisements targeted at those between the ages of 18-34,
- Presence among youth and college students such as summer camps,
- Legislative power resulting in some of the nation’s most protective life-saving laws for Wisconsin. Wisconsin Right to Life’s legislative expertise and knowledge of issues are eagerly sought by legislators who want to make a life-saving impact.
- Internet and Social Media Innovator to leverage social networks to bring about right-to-life change.
- Vibrant statewide grassroots network of regions and local county chapters who bring right-to-life activism, messages, and awareness to local communities.
