

Process for Confession

Waiting in Line

Please wait at the designated spaces marked by yellow tape until you can advance. If you are in line at a spot before the yellow tape begins, please stand at least six feet from the person in front of you.

We encourage you to wear a mask while in line. Some masks are available at the front door of the parish office if you need one.

Next in Line for Confession

If you are the next person for confession, please stay behind the final yellow line on the ramp up to the C1 / main door. When you see the person currently in confession depart the door, you can advance to the open door, which is fully screened.

Approaching and During Confession

Stand behind the yellow line at the open door. Father Bill will be on the other side of the screen in private. He will greet you, then join him in the sign of the cross, followed by confessing your sins. Father will ask you to say an individual act of contrition and give you absolution. If the line is long, he may lead the group in an act of contrition to save time.

After Your Confession

After completing your confession, if you are able, depart the front of the church down the stairs facing east, directly in front of the C1 doors. This will maintain social distancing. If you do need to depart via the ramp, allow the next person in line to move past you before heading down the ramp.
