BAPTISM: A sacrament instituted by Christ by which through the infusion of grace original sin is taken away.

BAPTISMAL Robe: The white garment worn by those to be baptized.

BLESSED SACRAMENT (CONSECRATED HOSTS): The part of the Canon of the mass at which the celebrant changes bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ.



CANDLE: A cylindrical wax stick or taper with a wick in the center used for illumination.



CANDLE HOLDER: Holds the candle.



CANDLE LIGHTER: Lights the candle.



CANTOR: Leads the congregation in praising God in song.



CHALICE: The cup-shaped vessel used in the Mass in which wine is consecrated.
