



Faith Formation Year 2020/2021 COVID-19 Preparedness Plan

- Start by coming back as full session groups with sanitization between sessions of classrooms, gathering spaces and rest rooms. If Cannon Falls School District changes plans due to the pandemic (closure due to outbreak in area, etc.) we would also go to the distance learning Faith Formation for that time period. (All distance learning Faith Formation will be done by the family.)
- No child or youth should come to church for Faith Formation if there are any signs of illness. (Email Director of Religious Ed for lessons to be completed at home - spvcfyouth@gmail.com)
- Classroom size will be larger as needed to allow for proper spacing.
- Hand sanitizer in every classroom. Wipes in every classroom. Buckets of bleach/sanitizer water ready for before and between sessions.
- Drinking fountain covered and not to be used.
- Adults and children/youth need to wear face coverings in the building during Faith Formation.
- Offering distance learning with follow-up online each week (only those that are not attending public school or specifically requested).
- No children or youth in building (except children of Catechists) until 5 minutes before class starts – parents bring elementary children to main lower level door and come to pick them up at side ramp door after session ends. We will have extra volunteers to monitor each week.
- No Youth Group until the pandemic ends.
- No LOTW during Mass for Children until the pandemic ends.
- Large Group Gathering/prayer will be divided for proper social distancing. X's on the floor as social distancing guides for gatherings – signs up as reminders for social distancing, face covering, handwashing, etc.

- Young children will have bags for supplies in classroom (no sharing crayons, pencils, scissors, etc.) older youth/children will have a plastic zip lock bag in classroom with pencil and any other needed items – all labeled for that person.
