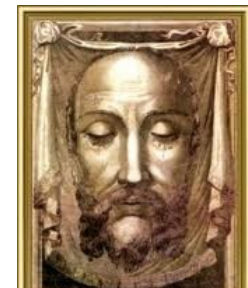

Dedicated Staff

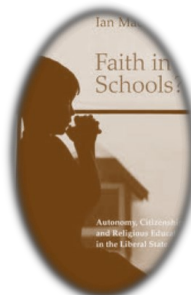
