From Fr. Tony

First of all, I want to congratulate our Confirmation candidates. 33 candidates were or will be confirmed from our area faith community at St. Anne's this weekend. May these sons and daughters of God, confirmed by the

gift of the Spirit, give witness to Christ by lives built on faith and love.

Also, I have been hearing more people who are telling me that they are getting e-mails and texts supposedly from me asking for gift cards. Again, I am not asking. Somehow someone has been using my name to take

advantage of people's generosity. If you are someone who has been asked to give me a gift card through texting or e-mailing, please let us know at the parish office. And please, whatever you do, DO NOT give them a gift card number. Please call us.

Speaking of call, as I mentioned in my homily last weekend, as our area faith community keeps moving forward with the talk of merging parishes, please call on our Lord to help us out during this difficult time. Ever since I mentioned in the bulletin the possibility may be that we may be going down to one priest for our area faith community by July 1, 2020, I have received several letters, e-mails, and phone calls of concerned and hurt people. First of all, none of our parishes will be closed, although it may appear like it when some of our parishes no longer have weekend Masses, but we can still celebrate weekday Masses, funerals, and weddings. Closing parishes and what happens to the buildings is up to the specific parishes. It will be up to the parishes to come up with plans on how to finance the buildings, etc. I also want to apologize for any hurt feelings. Although I knew that these feelings would accompany the announcement that is never the Bishop's, the dioceses, or my intentions. Please join me as we pray for our diocese and parishes. Hopefully in the next bulletin, I will share the roles and how the Bishop has asked the Handmaids of the Heart of Jesus to help us out in this process. In closing, I would like to share a quote that the Handmaids gave us at our first meeting with the Area Pastoral Planning Committee. Remember, God is always with us and has great plans for us, may find strength from Him to trust Him.

"For I know well the plans I have in mind for you, says the Lord, plans for your welfare and not for woe, plans to give you a future of hope. When you call me, when you go to pray to me, I will listen to you. When you look for me, you will find me. Yes, when you seek me with all your heart, I will let you find me, says the Lord, and I will change your lot." (Jeremiah 29:11-14)
