From Fr. Tony

This coming Wednesday night and on Thursday, our Church celebrates the Feast of the Assumption of Mary. Although this feast is a Holy Day obligation (meaning we are mortally wounded [we commit a serious sin] if we don't celebrate it), we come because we want to celebrate what Christ has done for us through Mary. Because Mary was willing to bring Christ into this world, God willed that her body be free from corruption when she goes into the next world. St. John Damascene says it best in Pope Pius XII's apostolic constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*: "It was necessary that she who had preserved her

virginity inviolate in childbirth should also have her body kept free from all corruption after death. It was necessary that she who had carried the Creator as a child on her breast should dwell in the tabernacles of God. It was necessary that the bride espoused by the Father should make her home in the bridal chambers of heaven. It was necessary that she, who had gazed on her crucified Son and pierced in the heart by the sword of sorrow which she had escaped in giving birth, should contemplate him seated with the Father. It was necessary that the Mother of God should share the possessions of her Son, and be

venerated by every creature as the Mother and handmaid of God.”

Because God invites us into this same loving relationship with him, it is necessary that we respond to his loving will! Like the Consecration Prayer that some of us received when we did the *33 Days to Morning Glory*, we are given Mary so that she can help us to be the perfect instrument in her hands to praise our God. As we believe the Dogma of the Immaculate Conception, Mary was conceived without sin. However, she remained sinless the rest of her life. Therefore, not only was she the Immaculate Tabernacle for our Lord to dwell within her, but the exact same person that dwell in her is also the same person who wants to dwell in us. We just need to be open to God as Mary did. This is why we are encouraged to turn to Mary to help us to listen, be obedient, and respond to His will. Mary always wants to help us, and that is why we have an obligation to celebrate and pray that this becomes the reality. Please join us at any of the Holy Day Masses this week, and celebrate what God has done for us. May we not become mortally wounded, but instead find healing, peace, protection, and love in Christ through Mary.
