### From Fr. Christian

**DON'T LOOSE HOPE, LOOK UNTO GOD.** In life there are moments of "Darkness" that is, moments of sorrow, pain, heartbreaks, disappointments, betrayals, failures etc. These moments of darkness are temporal for those who have faith in God and love Him with their whole being. In Psalm 112, David said: "When darkness overtakes the righteous, light will come bursting in" No condition is permanent for those who trust God. Darkness in the lives of faithful children of God invites light. Though you may not see any sign of light or God's favour now but still trust God; for God has arranged everything in your favour in the Spiritual realm. My dear, listen to what God is telling you: "I am going to do great things that I have never done before anywhere on Earth. People will see what great things I can do because I am going to

do something awesome for you"(Exodus 34:10). Am happy you have heard what God is promising you. Hope you will not forget me when the time comes. **TRY TO BE HAPPY NO MATTER WHAT YOU ARE PASSING THROUGH; YOU OWE YOURSELF HAPPINESS. LIFE IS TOO SHORT TO BE SPENT IN SADNESS.** Wait on God while being good to people, pray for God's mercy and don't allow praises depart from your lips. **From Fr. Tony**

I decided to switch things around a little in the bulletin today. As you just read Fr. Christian's article, I like to take a few moments and tie it into what Deacon John said at the Adult Formation Night this past Tuesday about prayer and our Gospel this past Thursday. As Fr. Christian wrote above, "In life there are moments of 'Darkness' that is, moments of sorrow, pain, heartbreaks, disappointments, betrayals, failures, etc." Sadly, we have all experienced moments like this, but like Fr. Christian wrote, we need to have faith in God and trust in Him. One of the ways that we can show our faith in God is through coming to him with our prayers. Like Jesus said in our Gospel this past Thursday, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light" (Mt 11:28-30).

Jesus wants us to tell Him our moments of darkness, to tell Him what is weighing us down. The other night, Deacon shared different ways we can pray and the importance for us to engage in a conversation with God. God wants to be in a relationship with us. He wants us to lay our burdens and labors before Him. Therefore, I encourage us, when we are in those moments of darkness, that we share them with our Lord. Don't ever feel you are alone, because, as Fr. Christian and Deacon both remind us, we are not. However, not only is God there to bring us rest and light from our darkness, labors, and burdens, but so is the Church.

Although our Lord knows what we are already burdened by, but still wants us to share them through prayer so that we can express our desires, the Church cannot read minds. That is why I also encourage you to share them with us – Fr. Christian, the deacons, and me. We are here to help. We want, if at all possible, to relieve you of your burdens and bring light to your darkness, but we encourage you to let us know. However, just like Jesus alluded in our Gospel that we will still have to take up our yoke (our crosses) and learn from Him, that doesn't mean we have to carry them alone. We will try our best to help in any way we can. Remember, God is here for you, and so are we. "God loves you so much," as Fr. Christian ended his article, and so do we. Let us help you in that love.
