From Fr. Tony

"Give us each day our daily bread" (Lk 11:3). These are the words from our Gospel this weekend. As I was reflecting on these words for this weekend's homily, as well as the bulletin, and the August calendar that you see attached to the bulletin, I decided to share a little bit about what will be happening this month of August in regards to our Lord's Daily Bread.

According to Canon Law 533, paragraph 2, priests are allowed to have a month off of vacation. Although I have been gone for a week so far this fiscal year, and I look to be on vacation in a couple weeks for another week of vacation, I never got the full 4 weeks off last year. I was only able to take off 2 weeks. Granted, it is my own fault. However, I have been blessed with parishioners who have been supportive and understanding when I am gone. With that being said, Fr. Christian will be gone

from August 6th to September 6th for a month of vacation.

When the Bishop asked that I will be the only pastor of our parishes, I knew that having daily Masses at all 6 parishes and 7 nursing homes would be somewhat of a concern. However, according to Canon Law (see Canon Law 905.2), a priest should only celebrate one weekday Mass. Although this may look like the Church does not want priests to celebrate Mass, it is insisting that the priest carries out his other tasks of governing and teaching, along with sanctifying. For example, I went on Tuesday down to the Children's Hospital in Minneapolis to visit Cassie Bliss the (daughter of Mark and Carrie Bliss), one of our 3rd grade parishioners who had a serious accident a week ago. If I were to have more than one Mass daily, I would not be able to visit my parishioners except for at our local hospital. I also try to make it a

point to visit the parishioners in various nursing homes throughout our state. Again, as I have written before, please let me know if you or a loved one would like a visit. Now, don't get me wrong, I love to celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, but I also like to do what the Church calls us priests to do in carrying out the other roles of our priestly ministry.

Recently I had a meeting with our area Worship & Spiritual Life Committee to talk about the August daily Mass schedule. It was decided at this meeting, as you will notice when you see the August calendar, there will be a limited number of Masses. The committee decided to limit these number of Masses to give us a glimpse of what it will look like when we are down to one priest. Some of our parishes will not be having a weekly Mass nor will some of our nursing homes be having a monthly Mass. As we celebrate the Sacrifice of the Mass, maybe we can see it as a sacrifice when it comes to where we are going for Mass or how often we are able to celebrate it in our parish or nursing home. I will do my best to bring our Lord's Daily Bread to you all. Please join me as we unite our sacrifices to that of our Lord. I pray Fr. Christian has a blessed and relaxing vacation, and may you all know that you, too, are in my thoughts and prayers.
