She has been teaching here for 8 years. They truly were and are a blessing to our parishes and school. We will miss seeing them regularly, but we hope to see them occasionally. May God bless them, as a new chapter opens for them. Also, we like to welcome David Wick. He is our new Youth Minister and Assistant Director of Religious

Education for our Area Faith Community (AFC). He and his wife Marilyn (Salfer) will be moving back to our area. I am excited to see how our youth and education programs will grow by his presence and ministry. Welcome David (and welcome back Marilyn)!

Although I know this is a tough thing to talk about and implement, we need to keep moving forward with carrying out the 4th Plan for Parishes and work toward two parishes with Sunday Masses by July 1, 2020. Our Lady of Victory, St. John, St. Mary, and St. Mathias will no longer have weekend Masses starting July 1, 2020. To help with this process and how we can work toward this

transition (Sr. Anna and Sr. Mary Angela – a couple of the Handmaids of the Heart of Jesus are also assisting), the following are the reps from the 5 parishes on the Parish Planning Committee: Annette Rohlik and Audrey Turbes (Our Lady), Annette Guetter and Justin Prokosch (St. Anne), Tom Ellig and Matt Buckley (St. Catherine), Brian Maertens and Christopher Turbes (St. Mary), and Bobbi Riley and Casey Leopold (St. Mathias). We also have Fr. Christian and Deacon Ryan involved on the committee. At our last meeting this week, we decided to send out a survey to help facilitate this process. We hope to have parish meetings in each of the parishes late summer or early fall. If you have questions or comments, please feel free to come to me or any one of these reps. Because the Church of St. John has decided to close June 30, 2019, we currently have no representation on this Area Planning Committee. However, if someone from the Church of St. John would like to be on this planning committee, please let me know. With that being said, please pray for our parishes.

The Church of St. John decided to close this June 30th, 2019 with that last Sunday of June being the last Mass. We will lock the doors, take the Blessed Sacrament and the Holy Oils to the Church of St. Catherine and no more sacraments will be celebrated in the church. The Church, rectory, property, and everything in the church and rectory will be left to be discussed throughout this next year. We are not rushing in deciding what to do with these things but will prayerfully discern this next year where to go with the furnishings and what to do with the buildings. Right now, we plan on tearing the church down next year sometime and sell the house and the church grounds afterwards. Again, please pray for one another and ask that the Holy Spirit, who Jesus said he will give to the apostles when He left them and ascended to the Father, will help us as well. Know of my prayers for all of you.
