### From Fr. Tony

First of all, I cannot thank enough those who have braved the cold, blistery weather to clean our sidewalks and our steps of our churches and school these last couple months. Your willingness and sacrifice to get up (and

sometimes quite early) to help clean off the snow is greatly appreciated. Speaking of sacrifice, this next week begins a holy season that reminds of the importance of sacrifice. Please use the following to have a blessed and fruitful Lent.

**LENT OBSERVANCES**

**PRAYER:** Enter into the liturgies of this season through adoration, Stations of the Cross (all of the churches will have it weekly), Reconciliation Services, individual confessions, and “*Eucharist*” and “*That Man is You*” Adult Ed gatherings, Mom’s Group, prayer groups (call parish office if interested), and Masses. Also, feel free to go online and use “Dynamic Catholic’s” website as part of your daily reflection: <https://dynamiccatholic.com/bestlentever> & [formed.org](https://dynamiccatholic.com/formed.org) for daily reflections.


**Lenten Reflection Booklets:** There are reflection and prayer books in all the churches to help with your individual devotion this Lenten Season. This year we are blessed with several options, like: *The Little Black Books*, *Lenten Meditations* attached to the bulletins (starting next week), and *Stations of the Cross* and other booklets available in the back of the churches. Feel free to take them and use them for your personal or family devotions during this season.

**FASTING/ABSTAINING:** Fasting is a wonderful way for us to let go of the desires that we think we need and instead put our trust in needing God to satisfy. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. *Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics, 14 years of age or older, must abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.*

**ALMSGIVING:** Almsgiving is a chance for us to recognize that we have been blessed in some form or other and in turn to reach out to satisfy the hungers of the world through our finances.

- Special Parish Projects** – This Ash Wednesday a portion of our collection will be used for our local food shelf, those who stop by asking for gas money and food (for parishes that do not have Salvation Army), and Youth Program.
- Black and Indian Missions** – Next week, March 10th, our parishes will take up the 135<sup>th</sup> Annual National Black and Indian Mission Collection. Our support of this collection helps build the Church in African, Native American, and Alaska Native communities from coast to coast. Schools, parish religious education programs, and diocesan ministries depend on your generosity to help them spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Catholic Relief Services Fund** – We will be collecting the envelopes for the American Bishops’ Overseas Appeal March 31st. These funds help places that are struggling with welfare and emergency needs.

- Home Missions** – We will be collecting envelopes for the National Collection for Home Missions April 28th. Many of these missionaries would not have been part of the Church’s evangelization work without the financial assistance of the National Collection. Contributing to the collection is our way of evangelizing and spreading God’s Gospel message to those who have never heard it.
- Holy Land** – On Good Friday (April 19), the only collection that is taken is sent to the Holy Land to preserve the buildings and the various holy sites and shrines. Our money helps in the restoration and the beautifying the area where our Lord once walked, died and rose.
- Operation Rice Bowl** – Operation Rice Bowl is Catholic Relief Service’s (CRS) annual Lenten program that makes an effort to raise awareness of the problem of global poverty and provides a means for Catholics of the U.S. to address global poverty. Throughout Lent, rice bowls is for the taking for daily collections of your change or a one-time donation. Please use the boxes in the back of the churches to help with this.
