From Fr. Tony

This past week, the priests of our diocese and the Bishop gathered for our annual Presbytery Day in Willmar. We began our afternoon with a meal, a talk given by Fr. Charles Lachowitz (Moderator of the Curia and Vicar General for the Archdiocese of St. Paul/Minneapolis), and then a meeting afterward. The meeting was just like any other meeting, but Fr. Charles gave a good talk.

He made reference to the Church as a ship. Sometimes the ship goes up at its crest and sometimes it

comes down at its troughs. So it is with the Church. We have certainly experienced a lot of ups and downs, and sometimes it feels like all we know is down. We experienced stormy waters and we continue to float in deep water. However, unlike Peter who panicked at the thought of walking on water and started drowning, with Christ's help, we do know how to swim.

Although bankruptcy is not a good thing on the outside, as Fr. Charles shared, it is a way to dock, get fixed, and then loosen the ropes and set sail again. Well, just like the Church with bankruptcy or the image of the

ship, all of us need to do the same thing every now and then and set time aside to be with our Lord to dock, get fixed, heal, restore, and then set sail again. We experience healing through the mercy of Jesus.

When it comes to the ship or the Church, there are no longer passengers on the ship. We are all just the crew – carrying out the mission of the Church to strengthen its unity. No matter how young or how old we are, we can all contribute somehow...even if it is through prayer. Although our Church looks wounded like a war ship coming back from battle, wounded by shortage of priests and people, lack of faith, and the terrible sexual abuse, we must not abandon ship. Instead, with the Spirit's help (tools, materials, maps, and instructions), we can rebuild our Church again. It may not look like it once did, but with the Spirit's help we will be a more vibrant Church that will once again withstand anything. As I made reference last week about each of us filling the gaps, please join me as we pray for our Church and ask the Captain to use us to rebuild His Church and help fill in the gaps. Are you ready and willing to help out? All hands on deck.

Speaking of deck, feel free to bring your lawn chairs from your decks and join us for our Memorial Day Masses. The 7am Mass at St. Mathias in Wanda and the 8am Mass at St. Catherine in Redwood Falls will be outside at their respective cemeteries. Mass at 8:30am at St. Anne in Wabasso will be held in church. Also, please take time to attend one of the many Memorial Day Service that our communities are hosting and help remember, celebrate, appreciate and pray for our past veterans and current military.

Finally, please pray for John Hayes and Shawn Polman who will be ordained to the diaconate on June 1st at the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity in New Ulm at 10 am. Then, shortly after ordination, soon-to-be Deacon John Hayes will be coming to our Area Faith Community (AFC) to help us and learn from us during the summer months.
