### From Fr. Tony

This past week, as some of you may know, Fr. Christian and I, and 40 other priests from our diocese (including the bishop) were on a retreat at Christ the King Retreat Center in Buffalo. Archbishop Hebda from St. Paul/Minneapolis was our retreat director. The theme of the retreat was "The Priest as a Man of Communion". Although it was centered on our ordained priestly ministry, there were some things that apply to our priestly ministry of the Baptized.

All of us, by our Baptism, were Baptized as *priest*, prophet, and king. With that priestly office, all of us share in Christ's office as a priest – offering our lives as

sacrifices to Him and one another. And how fitting that we should hear about our priestly office and being in communion, when we just celebrated First Holy Communion in most of the southern parishes last weekend, the northern parishes this weekend, and a couple more next weekend in Seaforth (which I am saddened that I won't be able to celebrate, but I'm looking forward to celebrating with the seniors at the Baccalaureate Masses in the northern parishes next weekend).

As a priestly people, sharing in Christ's priesthood, we share in His sacrificial love. In order to fully participate

and celebrate this sacrifice, we need to be in communion with Him and His Church. By being in communion with each other, we not only are able to share our gifts, but we are also able to receive and experience the gifts of others. In referring to what Cardinal Dolan once said, Archbishop Hebda shared how the last three popes had something to share the Church. St. John Paul II was known for his heart – he loved and welcomed all people and all faiths. Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI was known for his head – he was a very intellectual thinker. Pope Francis was known for his hands – he never stopped serving and calling us into service.

Therefore, as a priestly people, what are our gifts? To whom and how can we share them? No matter what happens to our parishes, how is God calling us to share our gifts? May God help us use the gifts we have to bring ourselves and others in greater communion with Him and His Church. May we too use our hearts to love, our heads to know how to do it, and our hands to put our love into action. As a man being called into communion and as a priest, know that I offer my prayers and life for all of you.

Speaking of communion, please join me as our Area Faith Community (AFC) gets together at the Matt and Bernadette Thooft farm on Wednesday, May 15th at 6pm. We will begin with Mass, bless their home and farm, and then bless some (organic) soil and crosses that you can use for your fields and gardens. There will be a potluck supper afterwards. For those in our northern parishes, we have been doing this for a few years now. If anyone wants to have their farm or homes blessed in any of the 6 parishes next year on or near the memorial of St. Isidore, the farmer, (May 15) please let me know. We celebrate on a farm or in town or just in the country. Please join us this year, as we pray that God blesses us with good planting weather. The Thoofts address is 25927 County Hwy 7, Wabasso, MN
