Mark your calendars for Sunday, April 15, when we celebrate our school with the annual Capital Campaign Dinner, "Building Together for God's Children".

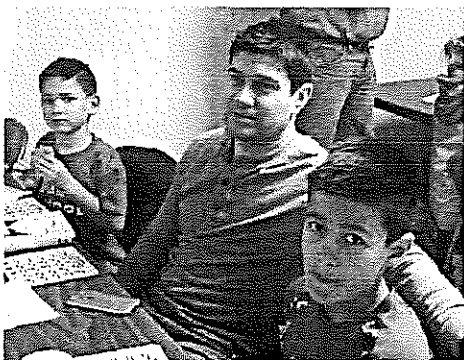

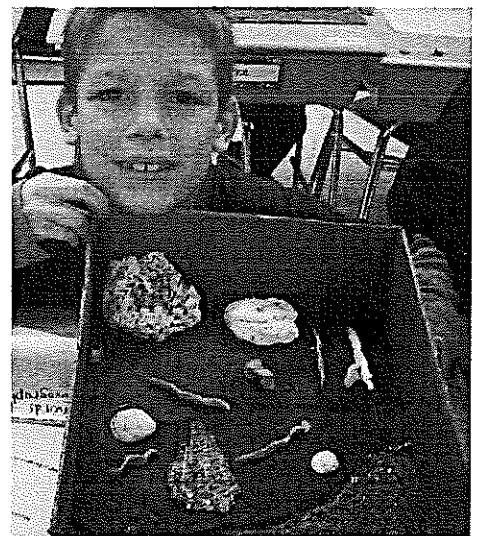
## Raffle Tickets

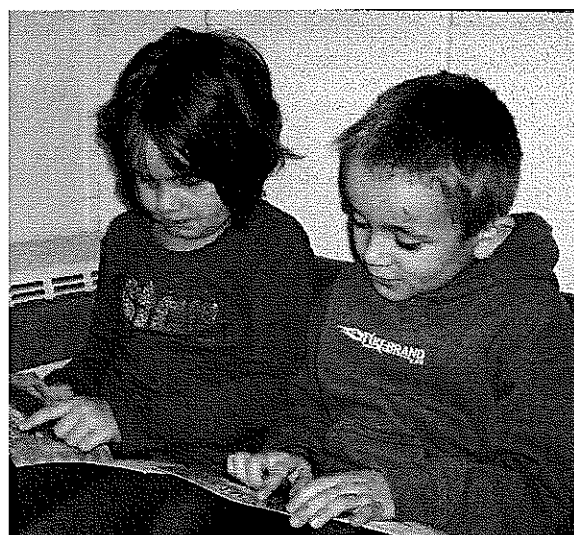
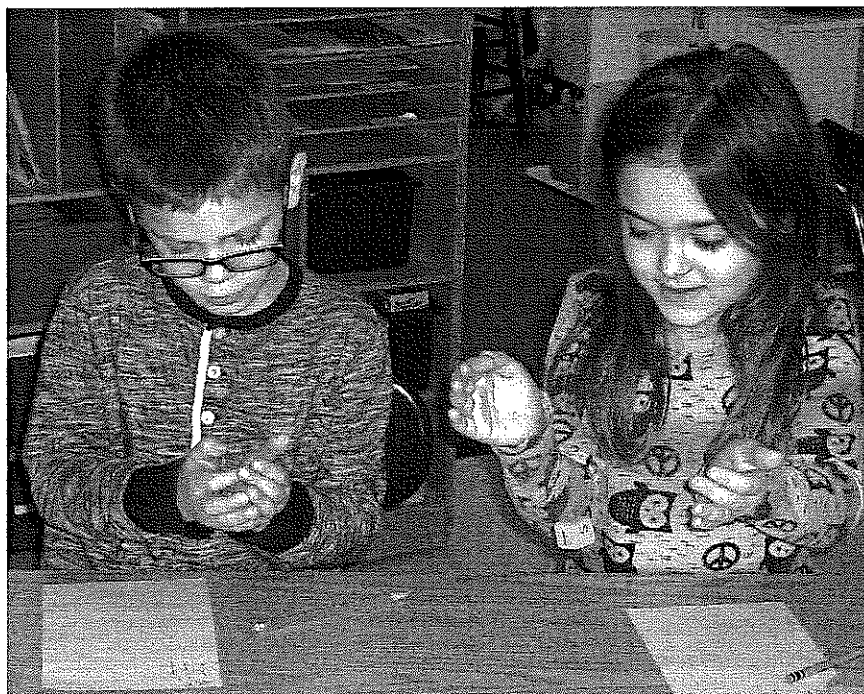

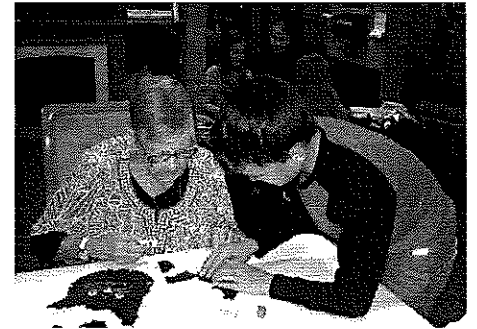

**News:** I'm a graduate of St. Anne's High School in 1950. The education I received was excellent. I then attended St. John's University, Collegeville, Minnesota, graduating in 1954. I attended Creighton University School of Medicine graduating in 1957. I married Audrey Price, also a graduate of St. Anne's High School, in June of 1957. We drove out to Letterman Army Hospital in San Francisco, California. We spent one year there. After that I was transferred to Tyndall Air Force Base in Panama City, Florida. I was flight surgeon there for 3 years. A flight surgeon does not do surgery. I took care of all the pilots at the air base. From there I went to St. Elizabeth Hospital for my surgical residency in Lincoln, Nebraska. After that we moved to Shakopee, Minnesota where I did Family Practice at the Chaska Medical Center and retired in 1998. Audrey passed away from breast cancer in 2001. I became Gentlemen Host on cruise ships, the Regent Line. In order to do this I had to be able to dance all the Latin dances that includes rumba, cha cha, tango, mambo, salsa, as well as waltz and an occasional polka and fox trot. I did that for six years. That is what it took timewise to see the entire world, including Antarctica and Northern Alaska.

Now I'm spending all my time in Shakopee. My dance partner, Gladys, passed away, so my dancing career has also come to an end. So what is next only the Lord knows.
