



St. Mary Catholic Church Human Concerns Endowment Fund Request Forms

Introduction

The Endowment Fund was established to provide perpetual funds for people in need of food, clothing, shelter, or health services. These funds are disbursed annually to non-profit organizations, either providing these direct services to people, or working to promote social justice. The funds should be used for people who reside within the parish or its diocese, and must be re-applied for each year.

In 1981, St. Mary's participated in the establishment of Marywood housing for the aged and disabled. Under the terms of the program, the parish received compensation for the land it provided. Sometime later, a portion of these proceeds was used to create The Fund for Human Concerns.

The fund was designed to operate for many years by adhering to a formula which channels a bulk of its earnings to those in need, while preserving the core investment.

In the years since its inception, it has addressed a wide range of human needs.
