Session Four Discussion Questions

PART 1

- 1) The Gospel recounts for us one of the many stories of Jesus, the healer. Here we see many characters: the blind man, the community, the parents, the Pharisees. Who are you in this story at this moment? Why do you relate to that person or persons?
- 2) Where do you see images of water and light in this story? Where do you see images of Baptism in this story?

PART 2

- 1) The parents of the blind man are afraid to witness for their son. They fear reprisal. The blind man is not afraid. Why is their perspective different? Is there a place this week where you could witness to your growing faith?
- 2) Last week we saw a powerful example of evangelization from the woman at the well. This week, the man born blind becomes another example of what it means to evangelize. How would our communities change if we followed their example?
