- 7. The student provides recommendations from a church leader and a High School administrator (teacher, principal, coach, etc.)

The application and supporting material must be postmarked no later than <u>January 31, 2021</u> for scholarship consideration for the fall semester of 2021. These items must be mailed via first class mail.

Winner of the scholarship will be announced at a Luncheon on Sunday, <u>TBD</u> at 12:30 pm in St. Mary's Lower Commons. All applicants and their families are welcome to attend.
