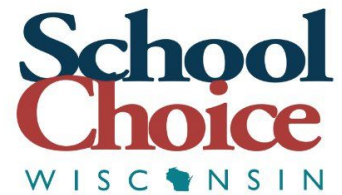


Did you know that your children could attend a private school in Wisconsin tuition-free?



The St. Patrick School Education Committee and School Administration have decided to enroll in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) for the 2018-19 School Year.

This program will allow eligible students who reside in Wisconsin and meet the state requirements to attend Catholic school tuition-free.

We will have a limited amount of student slots available - - - and are trying to gauge which grades to enroll students. If your family is interested, please contact St. School for more information or to show interest in enrolling.

When to Apply

Apply online between February 1 through mid April. Apply early! Late applications for the voucher program will not be accepted for any reason by the state. More information with online links will be available after the new year.

Entrance Requirements

Any new incoming student entering kindergarten through 12th grade who meets the eligibility requirements may apply. Currently enrolled St Patrick students entering into kindergarten and first grade are eligible to apply for the 2018-19 voucher program.
