

GOD IS ALMIGHTY



What does it mean to say that God is almighty?

God reveals himself as "the strong One, the mighty One" (*Psalm 24:8*), as the One "to whom nothing is impossible" (*Luke 1:37*). His omnipotence is universal, mysterious and shows itself in the creation of the world out of nothing and humanity out of love; but above all it shows itself in the Incarnation and the Resurrection of his Son, in the gift of filial adoption and in the forgiveness of sins. For this reason, the Church directs her prayers to the "almighty and eternal God" ("*Omnipotens sempiterne Deus...*"). (*Catechism of the Catholic Church Comp. n. 50*)

Saint Kateri Rosary Walk Internship

For the third summer in a row, college-aged men can apply to join a unique, paid summer experience building a shrine by hand in the desert southwest, in honor of the first Native American saint Saint Kateri Tekakwitha. You will serve as missionaries to the Catholic Diocese of Gallup, performing manual labor to help build the Saint Kateri Rosary Walk by hand. You will learn how to use traditional Southwestern building materials and techniques. The highly structured program includes spiritual and academic formation for the missionary interns as well as opportunities to travel while experiencing the life and history of the Catholic Southwest. The internship will run from June 4, 2022 to August 7, 2022, in Gallup, New Mexico.



The Southwest Indian Foundation is accepting applications through **February 25, 2022** to fill a limited number of positions in the internship program. Those who are accepted into the program will receive free housing, most meals, and a stipend for the entire summer of \$ 4,200.00 USD.
