Time: 2:30 pm




Diocesan Mission for Renewal in the Faith - I BELIEVE IN ONE GOD

Why does one profess belief that there is only one God?

Belief in the one God is professed because he has revealed himself to the people of Israel as the only One when he said, "Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God is one Lord" (*Deuteronomy 6:4*) and "there is no other" (*Isaiah 45:22*). Jesus himself confirmed that God is "the one Lord" (*Mark 12:29*). To confess that Jesus and the Holy Spirit are also God and Lord does not introduce any division into the one God. (*Catechism of the Catholic Church Comp. n. 37*)

Men's Group

Tony Flores will present "Strong Fathers, Strong Daughters" by Meg Meeker, M.D., in eight sessions, to our men's group. The group will meet Tuesday nights from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The eight week program will cover the following topics.

Session 1, Part 1: You are the most important man in her life.

And he (John The Baptist) will go on before the Lord, in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the Fathers to their sons, and incredulous to the prudence of the just, so as to prepare for the Lord a completed people. -Luke 1:17

Session 2, Part 2: You are the most important man in her life.

Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but educate them with the discipline and correction of the Lord. Ephesians 6:4

Session 3: Be the man you want her to marry.

Praise ye the Lord, Blessed is the man that feareth the Lord that delighteth greatly in his commandments. His seed shall be mighty upon earth: The generation of the upright shall be blessed. Psalm 112:1-2

Session 4: Teach her humility

Therefore, if I your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash the feet of one another. For I have given you an example, so that just as I have done for you, so also should you do. Amen, amen, I say to you, the servant is not greater than his Lord, and the Apostle is not greater than he who sent him. If you understand this, you shall be blessed if you will do it. -John 13:14-17

Session 5, Part 1: Protect Her, Defend Her

So I stationed the people in order, in places behind the wall, all around it with their swords, and lances and bows. And I gazed around, and I rose up. And I said to the nobles, and to the magistrates, and to the rest of the common people Do not be afraid before their face. Remember the great and terrible Lord, and fight on behalf of your brothers, your sons, and your daughters, and your wives and your households. Nehemiah 4:13-14

Session 6, Part 2: Protect Her, Defend Her

Charity suffers all, believes all, hopes all, endures all. Charity is never torn away, even if prophecies pass away. -1 Corinthians 13:7-8

Session 7: Teach Her To Fight

And do not choose to be conformed to this age but instead choose to be reformed in the newness of your mind, so that you may demonstrate what is the will of God: what is good, and what is well-pleasing, and what is perfect. -Romans 12:2

Session 8: Teach Her Who God Is

Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These Commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the door frames of your houses and on your gates. -Deuteronomy 6:4-9
