1. Fr. Vu opened the meeting with prayer
2. The parish received 7 closed bids for the same of 4 lots behind former St. Patrick's School. Discussion of the bids and a motion made by Cindy Schmerbach and a second by Luke Reichert to accept the bid from Habitat for Humanity (recommendation from the Finance Council). Unanimous vote for approval.
3. Future meetings for Parish council will be moved to Tuesday at 6:30pm. These will take place every other month.
4. We discussed safety measure for during mass times, as well as, the safety of those that are in the building. Fr. Vu will be looking into some video options.
5. Totus Tuus will be coming this summer to St. John XXIII. We will work jointly with St. Jude's on this. More to come in the near future.
6. The festival dinner and silent auction has had some good results. Not all items are in. Estimate is that the live auction raised about \$4k more than 2017.
7. Our church building is starting to show some wear and we are going to be forced to some repairs in the near future. We are in need of some "NO PARKING SIGNS" for the grass area. We have a new area for parking, so there is no need to park in the grassy area around the church.
