My Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

This coming week I will be on vacation and thus, there will not be weekday Masses scheduled here at the parish. However, a familiar face returns to our parish family. Our seminarian, **Andrew Meng**, has returned from his intensive Spanish immersion study in Guatemala. We welcome Andrew home! Andrew will conduct a Communion Service here on Thursday and Friday of this week at 7:30 a.m. and on Monday thru Wednesday of next week. Perhaps he will speak a few words to us in English! Daily Mass is celebrated each morning at 8:00 a.m. on Monday thru Saturday at St. James the Greater Parish in Augusta.

Our parish family was blessed to have Andrew working here for four months from February through mid-May. He will be living here at the rectory until mid-August when he returns to Mundelein Seminary in Chicago, where he enters his third year of theology. In these next four weeks, Andrew will be working at the Catholic Care Center in Wichita, learning the important ministry of pastoral care for the elderly. On weekends, he will serve at our Sunday Masses as he did earlier this year. Please pray for Andrew and for our native son, **Caleb Kuestersteffen**, who will be returning in August to continue his seminary studies at the St. Joseph House of Formation in Wichita. Remember the words of last Sunday's Gospel? "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." Pray for vocations to the priesthood and consecrated religious life and that the young people of our parish may know the vocation to which God calls each of them.
