ELECTRONIC GIVING PROGRAM

At the request of many of our families, we are happy to inform you that the St. John Neumann Electronic Giving Program is offered to our parishioners. It is a direct payment program which is a safe, smart, and a “green way” to make your contribution to our parish. You can decide not to participate in this option and continue with the traditional use of your weekly offertory envelope.



Electronic giving allows you the freedom of setting up the monthly, contributions to support your church. Your contribution would then be automatically debited from your checking or savings account and deposited into the parish account. It also promises a great savings for us on mailings, stamps, and contribution envelopes, etc.

Commonly known as “Direct Payment” in the commercial world, electronic giving/payment, is reliable, accurate, on time and confidential. If a problem occurs, it’s easy to resolve by calling the Parish Business Manager, Deacon David Kolesky. For your financial protection, electronic payments are overseen and protected under Federal Reserve regulations.



For those of you who already use your computers to pay bills, here is another option. You might prefer to establish, through your own bank, a “Recurring Bill Pay” account which will allow you to make your contribution automatically.
