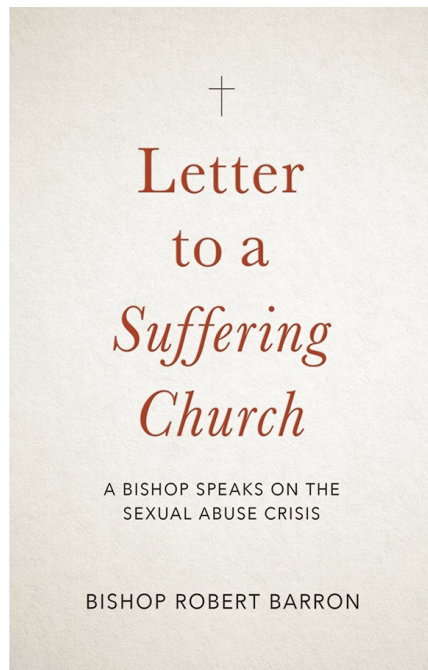
Book and Potluck Announcement

It is titled *Letter to a Suffering Church: A Bishop Speaks on Sexual Abuse Crisis*, by Bishop Robert Barron. We are inviting you to pick up a copy after mass. (A \$1.00 donation is appreciated to cover the cost) Read the book, discuss it with your family, spouse, friends or pray about it.

Our Patron Saint, St. Jude, is known for being a refuge for "lost causes" and impossible situations. He is a perfect friend for us at this time. His feast day is Monday, Oct. 28. . . .so let's celebrate him on the following Sunday, Nov 3, with a big parish event!
