Elementary Religious Education is for those in grades 1 through 5th grades on Wednesdays from 6:00 – 7:15 pm. Our Elementary Religious Education program works to form the entire child in understanding of the Catholic Faith, growing in relationship with Jesus Christ and fostering a spirit of prayer.

During these crazy and challenging times, our goal is to provide the safest and most reasonable options for our families. Because the registration numbers are currently down, the majority of our elementary families are choosing a home study model and the Bishop has extended the dispensation to attend Public Masses until November 1, we have decided to move all of our 1st -5th grade classes to a virtual/home study model through October. It is our hope that we can gather in person in November.

For now, our schedule will have the following components:

- Pre-recorded Parent Videos
 - The pre-recorded parent videos will provide tips and strategies for each month as well as share any important information.
- LIVE Zoom classes with catechist
 - The LIVE Zoom classes will be a great way for the kids to interact with their age group and the catechists will lead the children in an age appropriate lesson
- 2 Family Home School lessons
 - Each of the home school lessons will be provided with materials and simple plans for parents.
