



Middle School Religious Education/Youth Ministry

Our Middle School Religious Education/Youth Ministry program is for those in grades 6-8 and meets on Sunday nights from 6-7:15pm (following our 5PM Mass). Our middle school program provides small group interaction, prayer experiences, games and other activities all with the goal of helping our teens understand who they are and who Christ is in their lives.

Due to COVID-19, we will be offering two options for our families, an in-person option and a home study option.

In-Person Option:

Utilizing the EDGE curriculum from Life Teen, we share the beauty of our Catholic Faith and how and why it is important in their lives today. We highly encourage involvement in our Middle School program before registering for the Confirmation program in High School.

Home Study Option:

All 6th-8th grade students who choose to do a home study option will be a part of our Chosen series. Teens will receive a workbook and a digital access code from Ascension Press. They will then watch the assigned video and do the weekly lessons assigned, we recommend that the parents discuss with the teens, or if there are more than one teen participating, that they dialogue together. There will be an introduction and overview of the year for both parents and youth via zoom on September 28 from 7pm-8pm (the Zoom log in will be sent the week before). Starting in November and thereafter, the first Monday we will meet via zoom to discuss what has been done. There will be two - three sessions youth complete at home independently.
